

Communications Intern

Job Summary

The Communications Intern is a semester-long position that will provide support and leadership to various aspects of the communication aspects of the ministry. They will work to achieve the mission and vision of Rainbow's End Youth Services (REYS) through the building and strengthening of relationships with students and volunteers. The Communications Intern will also work alongside the Executive Director, Director of Student Ministries, and other staff and volunteers to serve the students and volunteers through direct and indirect student ministry. Emphasis will be on creating content and communicating the mission of REYS to the community at large.

Primary Responsibilities and Commitments

- Assisting staff with promoting events, tracking, formatting and archiving reviews and other media.
- Assisting in maintaining and updating the Rainbow's End Youth Services social media sites.
- Assisting in the production of advertisements, press releases, and promotional materials.

- Manage weekly, monthly and annual projects as assigned by the Executive Director and Director of Student Ministries.
- Prioritize relationship building with all youth who walk through the doors of REYS
- Schedule may vary to accommodate REYS program needs
- Hours are typically 10-15 hours a week
- Other duties as assigned.
